About Your Program

To offer you a flexible learning journey with relevant and classroom-ready skills, we have made some improvements to your Graduate Diploma of Early Childhood Education and Care (GDCH) program with the flexible academic calendar starting in <u>Trimester 1, 2024</u>.

This Graduate Diploma of Early Childhood Education and Care (GDCH) guide contains all the information that you need to know about your program. The GDCH is an 8 credit point (8 course) program with at least sixty (60) days of professional experience.

Section 1: Planning My Enrolment Pattern

New and Continuing Students

In the trimester academic calendar, new and continuing students will study in "trimesters" rather than "semesters". There are minimal changes to your enrolment pattern because current courses continue to be offered in the matching trimesters – for example, if a course was previously offered in semester 1, it will be offered in trimester 1.

The trimester calendar offers a great deal of flexibility to allow you to speed up or slow down your studies. It also allows you to study in all three trimesters in a calendar year and still have a break (approx. 6 weeks) in your studies over the end of year holiday period.

Continuing Students – Minor Change

For continuing students, there has been a minor change to EDU4160 Numeracy, Literacy and STEM in Early Childhood.

The 2023 course is:

• EDU4160 Numeracy, Literacy and STEM in Early Childhood

This course has changed with a new course code and name in 2024 to become:

• EDU4199 Numeracy, Literacy and STEM in Early Childhood Professional Experience

If you have completed EDU4160 Numeracy, Literacy and STEM in Early Childhood in Transition Semester 3 2023 or prior you will not be required to take any action.

If you have not yet completed EDU4160 Numeracy, Literacy and STEM in Early Childhood, you will transition to EDU4199 Numeracy, Literacy and STEM in Early Childhood Professional Experience. This course continues to be offered in trimester 3 and your progression in not affected.



Recommended Enrolment Patterns

This online and external program is comprised of eight courses which can be completed full-time in one year with enrolment in three consecutive semesters.

Students intending to complete the program full-time in 1 year with three consecutive trimesters of study are advised to follow the recommended enrolment pattern with a Professional Experience placement every semester.

Commencing Trimester 1 (2+3+3 pattern)

Commencing Trimester 2 (3+3+2 pattern)

Commencing Trimester 3 (3+3+2 pattern)

Alternatively, you may choose to study in a part-time pathway if you want to do fewer courses across the year. This might help you to balance work, study, family, professional experience placements and other commitments.

Professional Experience

The required 60 days of professional experience includes:

- 10 days with children under 3 years of age (birth-35 months)
- At least 20 days with children aged 3 5 years of age
- The remaining 30 days in an early childhood or other approved setting.

It is recommended you enrol into your professional experience courses well in advance of their commencement date (it is recommended you enrol during the preceding trimester). This allows the Work Integrated Learning (WIL) team sufficient time to source and confirm your placement. Please note, you can take a maximum of one professional experience course in each trimester. Dates for your professional experiences (placements) are available on the UniSQ Education Placements website.
