

Campus Emergency Procedures

Emergencies on campus may occur and it is important that we are all aware of the range of responses in place. The type of response is informed by a comprehensive framework of policies, procedures and plans.

Tools such as the Campus Emergency Procedure, shown below and available here, include various emergency codes in accordance with Australian standards. In an emergency, it is important to stay calm, consider your immediate safety, and call the University emergency number, extension 2222 or 4631 2222. You can also activate an emergency through the SafeZone app by pressing the emergency button. If the emergency is life-threatening, please call 000, and then follow up with a call to the University emergency number.
