



AWARD CONDITIONS - 2024

John Cole Scholarship

Value

The scholarship will have a maximum value of \$1000 to be paid in one instalment.

Eligibility

Recipient must:

- be a domestic student currently residing in Australia
- have a connection to the South Burnett Regional Council, or Cherbourg Aboriginal Shire Council local government area (defined by postcodes 4314, 4605, 4606, 4608, 4610, 4611, 4612, 4613, 4615)
- be continuing their studies full-time at UniSQ in a bachelor's degree program in Study Period 1 2024 (i.e., Trimester 1 2024)
- have, as at the release of results for Semester 2 2023:
 - a minimum of 4 study units completed and credited towards their current program
 - a Grade Point Average (GPA) of at least 4.0.

Conditions

- The duration of the scholarship is for 1 study period.
- The scholarship will be forfeited if the recipient:
 - fails to continue to meet the eligibility criteria for the duration of the scholarship
 - does not enrol full-time (minimum 3 study units) in Study Period 1 2024 (e.g., Trimester 1 2024).
- UniSQ reserves the right to alter the conditions of the scholarship.

Payment

- Payments are made approximately 4 weeks after the first census date in the study period of the recipient's program.
- Payment will be credited to the recipient's bank account in one instalment, as follows:
 - Study Period 1 - \$1000
