AWARD CONDITIONS - 2024

John Ross Clancy Indigenous Student Bursary

Value

The bursary will have a maximum value of \$1000 to be paid in one instalment.

Eligibility

Recipient must:

- be a domestic student currently residing in Australia
- be an Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander person of Australia
- be continuing their studies at UniSQ in a bachelor's degree program in Study Period 1 2024 (e.g., Trimester 1 2024)
- have a Grade Point Average (GPA) of at least 4.0 as at the release of results for Semester 2 2023.

Conditions

- The duration of the bursary is for 1 study period.
- The bursary will be forfeited if the recipient:
 - fails to continue to meet the eligibility criteria for the duration of the bursary
 - does not enrol in a minimum of 1 study unit in Study Period 1 2024 (e.g., Trimester 1 2024).
- UniSQ reserves the right to alter the conditions of the bursary.

Payment

- Payments are made approximately 4 weeks after the first census date in the study period of the recipient's program.
- Payment will be credited to the recipient's bank account in one instalment, as follows:
 - Study Period 1 - \$1000
