



ADF Veterans Scholarship

Value

The scholarship will have a maximum value of \$12 000 to be paid over 3 years.

Eligibility

Recipient must:

- be a domestic student residing in Australia
- meet the following Australian Defence Force (ADF) service requirements:
 - have left full-time service with the ADF within the last 5 years, or transition (if not already) from full-time service in 2025; and
 - have completed operational service as part of their ADF service
- be a commencing student
- be intending to enrol full-time at UniSQ in a bachelor's degree program in Study Period 1 2025 (e.g., Trimester 1 2025)
- not have already attained a tertiary qualification at a bachelor level or higher.

Conditions

- The duration of the scholarship is for up to 3 years (not inclusive of any Leave of Absence).
- The scholarship will be forfeited if the recipient:
 - fails to continue to meet the eligibility criteria for the duration of the scholarship
 - does not enrol in a minimum of 6 study units across each academic year, for the duration of the scholarship, as follows:
 - minimum 3 study units in Study Period 1; and
 - minimum 3 study units across Study Periods 2 and 3
 - defers their program of study
 - takes more than 12 months total Leave of Absence
 - withdraws from study at UniSQ
 - fails to maintain a Grade Point Average (GPA) of at least 4.0
 - does not transition from full-time service in the first year of enrolment at UniSQ.
- If not already transitioned, it is the recipient's responsibility to provide the Scholarship Office, via email study@unisq.edu.au, with a copy of the Notice of Discharge immediately upon receipt and no later than 31 December 2025.
- UniSQ reserves the right to alter the conditions of the scholarship.

Payment

- Payments are made approximately 4 weeks after the census date in Study Period 1.
- Payments will be credited to the recipient's bank account in one instalment each year, for the duration of the scholarship, as follows:
 - Study Period 1 - \$4000
- Payment of subsequent instalments will be subject to satisfactory progress in the recipient's study program. In the event the recipient does not continue to meet the scholarship's eligibility criteria and conditions, they may be required to show cause why the scholarship should not be cancelled.
