

# **AWARD CONDITIONS - 2025**

# **Brazil Family Foundation Agricultural Scholarship**

### **Value**

The scholarship will have a maximum value of \$24 000 to be paid over 3 years.

## **Eligibility**

Recipient must:

- be a domestic student currently residing in Australia
- be a commencing student
- be intending to enrol full-time at UniSQ in Study Period 1 2025 (e.g., Trimester 1 2025), in one of the following programs (including double degree programs):
  - o Bachelor of Agricultural Technology and Management
  - Bachelor of Engineering (Honours) (Agricultural Engineering)
  - Bachelor of Science (Animal Science)
  - Bachelor of Science (Food Science)
  - o Bachelor of Science (Plant Agricultural Science)
  - o Bachelor of Science (Honours) (Agriculture).

### **Conditions**

- The duration of the scholarship is for up to 3 years (not inclusive of any Leave of Absence).
- The scholarship will be forfeited if the recipient:
  - o fails to continue to meet the eligibility criteria for the duration of the scholarship
  - o changes their program outside of the eligible programs
  - o does not enrol in a minimum of 6 study units across each academic year, for the duration of the scholarship, as follows:
    - minimum 3 study units in Study Period 1; and
    - minimum 3 study units across Study Periods 2 and 3
  - o defers their program of study
  - o takes more than 12 months total Leave of Absence
  - withdraws from study at UniSQ
  - o fails to maintain a Grade Point Average (GPA) of at least 4.0.
- UniSQ reserves the right to alter the conditions of the scholarship.

### Payment

- Payments are made approximately 4 weeks after the census date in Study Period 1 and Study Period 3.
- Payments will be credited to the recipient's bank account in two instalments each year, for the duration of the scholarship, as follows:
  - Study Period 1 \$4000
  - Study Period 3 \$4000



# **AWARD CONDITIONS - 2025**

 Payment of subsequent instalments will be subject to satisfactory progress in the recipient's study program. In the event the recipient does not continue to meet the scholarship's eligibility criteria and conditions, they may be required to show cause why the scholarship should not be cancelled.
