

AWARD CONDITIONS - 2025

Clinical Placement Bursary, Placement Bursary and Residential School Bursary

Value

The bursary value will range from \$250 to \$1000 and will be paid in one instalment.

Eligibility

Placement Bursary and Residential School Bursary recipients must:

- be a domestic student currently residing in Australia
- be enrolled at UniSQ in an undergraduate program with a compulsory placement or residential school in the study period of application
 - o continuing students have a current Grade Point Average (GPA) of at least 4.0
- have an annual household income that demonstrates low socio-economic circumstances and financial need.

Clinical Placement Bursary recipients must:

- be a domestic student currently residing in Australia, or an international on-campus student
- be enrolled at UniSQ in the Bachelor of Nursing, or Bachelor of Midwifery (Graduate Entry) in the study period of application
- have, as at the bursary closing date:
 - $\circ~$ a minimum of 8 study units (or equivalent exemptions) completed and credited towards the Bachelor of Nursing; or
 - a minimum of 4 study units (or equivalent exemptions) completed and credited towards the Bachelor of Midwifery (Graduate Entry)
 - o a current Grade Point Average (GPA) of at least 4.0
- attend a placement located more than 80 km from their term-time address
- have an annual household income that demonstrates low socio-economic circumstances and financial need.

Conditions

- The duration of the bursary is for 1 study period.
- Recipients must use the funds to cover expenses incurred during their placement or residential school.
- UniSQ reserves the right to alter the conditions of the bursary, and to not award the bursary in any given study period.

Payment

- Payment is made approximately 4 weeks after the census date in the study period of application.
- Payment will be credited to the recipient's bank account in one instalment, as follows:
 - \circ \$250 \$1000, depending on the hours of the placement or residential school in the study period of application.
